



Dalcroze Eurhythmics Class for Children

What is Dalcroze Eurhythmics?

Dalcroze Eurhythmics is a method that uses movement to teach music to children of all ages. Through groundbreaking techniques incorporating rhythmic movement, aural training, and physical, vocal and instrumental improvisation. Exploring rhythm and melody, children can learn to express themselves using their first instrument: their bodies. Your child can learn about beat, pitch, tempo, meter, dynamics, melodic direction, phrases, duration and many other subjects that students will need later on to play any instrument. Students can also learn to develop good concentration, listening skills and attention; skills they need for every day life.

Classes are 45 minutes long, are once a week for 10 weeks, and begin the third week of August. Cost is \$35 non-refundable registration fee plus program fee \$180. 10% discount off program fee for additional siblings. 15% total discount for members. Minimum 5 children per class, maximum 10.

The Eurhythmics classes have three components:

1. "Eurhythmics" (which means "good rhythm" or "good flow"): also called "locomotor" activities, in which the students move to the music and express the specific subject.
2. "Solfege": students can develop good listening and singing skills, and begins to understand pitch, melody, scale, etc, in an age appropriate setting.
3. "Improvisation": using what they just learned, students can learn to improvise with movement, singing, props or percussion instruments, and express their personal understanding of music.

Taught by a certified Dalcroze instructor, Isabel Aybar holds a Bachelor in Psychology from the Instituto Tecnológico de Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, and a Dalcroze Eurhythmics Certificate from the Longy School of Music, Boston, MA. Aybar has been teaching Eurhythmics classes to children between 6-months and 10-years of age since 2005 at music institutions such as The Longy School of Music, New England Conservatory and Concord Conservatory of Music. She also teaches private piano classes, group keyboard lessons and special needs children.
